Our goal is to help your organization achieve its disaster preparedness goals, at a cost that fits your organization's budget. SF CARD provides the following services and benefits to all nonprofit and faith-based organizations:

Membership Levels & Yearly Dues

Bronze Level: \$500 - The Bronze level is geared towards organizations that need a hand with creating and updating documented continuity plans, and would like basic-level trainings.

Members at this level will:

- Be provided up to 4 hours of technical assistance (within 12 months of joining).
- The type of services offered includes:
 - One-on-one assistance from our certified continuity consultants,
 - Staff trainings focused on staff readiness & safe evacuation practices.

Silver Level: \$800 - The Silver level is geared towards organizations that would like help updating their current continuity plans, and support for yearly staff trainings.

Members at this level will receive all the benefits of a Bronze Level Membership, as well as:

- 4 additional hours of technical assistance, total of 8 hours (within 12 months of joining).
- Tabletop exercises will be tailored for the organization and will focus on:
 - The basic Incident Command System (ICS),
 - Leadership readiness training.

Gold Level: \$1,000 - The Gold level is intended for organizations that want advanced guidance and technical assistance with their continuity plans and leadership trainings and exercises.

Members at this level will receive all the benefits of a Bronze and Silver Level Membership, as well as:

- 2 additional hours of technical assistance, total of 10 hours (within 12 months of joining).
- The focus of gold level trainings and exercises include:
 - Roles & responsibilities training for floor wardens and safety monitors,
 - Advanced Incident Command System training & exercise,
 - Psychological First Aid training for leadership and frontline staff.

Platinum Level: \$2,000 - The Platinum level is intended for large organizations (over 1-million dollars annual revenue) that want to sustain and advance their continuity plans and strengthen leadership response abilities through intensive trainings and exercises.

- Members on this level will receive all the benefits of a Bronze, Silver, and Gold Level Membership, as well as 2 additional hours of technical assistance, total of 12 hours (within 12 months of joining).
